The party (ies) named above agree to the following conditions concerning this exhibition:

1. Guest artist will show work in Art on Main for a three month period.
2. The responsibility for shipping to the gallery, loading, unloading, and delivery rests with the artist.
3. Please note that there is no available storage space on the premises, and all artwork must be removed promptly at the end of the three month period. Any work left after the removal date will be removed by gallery personnel at the risk of the artist.
4. Art on Main will cover publicity (press releases, listings, ads, newsletters, announcements, etc.). The artist shall provide Art on Main with images description/artist statement for the Art on Main website.
5. The artist shall provide a list to the gallery for all works to be displayed in order to prepare labels for the artwork. Information will include the following in the listed order: title, year, medium, size, and price.
6. The artist shall be responsible for insurance coverage of his/her artworks while on display at the AOM Gallery and shop.
7. It is agreed that the ownership and copyright of the works on exhibit listed above will be retained by the artist. The artwork will not be reproduced or copied in part or in total in any medium without the express permission of the artist. The artist gives permission for the reproduction/copying of the artwork for the purposes of documentation and publicity only. The artwork will not be shown by the gallery in any other form than that agreed to here.
8. Art on Main shall retain 45% commission on all sales occurring while artworks are on display in the gallery. A cheque in the amount of total sales, minus the commission, shall be issued to the artist by the middle of the month following the sale of the work, and shall be subject to the regular bookkeeping practices of Art on Main.
9. The artist agrees to not negotiate any sales resulting from the exhibition outside of the gallery during the period that the work is on display. All sales occurring as a result of the exhibition must be processed through the gallery.

It is further agreed that this contract is made in good faith between the artist and the gallery.

In the event that this contract should be cancelled before its completion, it is agreed that this cancellation must be with the express agreement of both parties. Neither party has the right to break this contract unilaterally. If this contract is to be cancelled, it is agreed that this cancellation will take place 90 days before the opening of the exhibition or before any publicity to do with the exhibition has been issued. In the event that the Artist cancels the exhibition less than 30 days before the opening, he/she shall reimburse the gallery all monies spent for advertising & promotion on their behalf. Finally, it is agreed by both parties that all terms of this contract must be expressed and that there are no implied terms to this agreement.
